RESULTS

The projectiles in Submissions 5 and 17 were fired in the gun in Submission 20. The cartridge cases in Submissions 14 and 15 were fired in the gun in Submission 20. The cartridge case in Submission 16 bears class and some individual characteristics consistent with those produced by the gun in Submission 20, but could not be positively included or excluded as having been fired in the gun in Submission 20 to the exclusion of all other firearms bearing the same class characteristics.
